

**STAGING**  
Staging may take place on Sunday 20th June 2010 from 10.00 am to 6.00 pm and Monday 21st June from 9.00 am to 3.30 p.m.

Judging will take place on Monday 21st June 2010 at 4.00 p.m.

Competitors must report to the Competitions Secretary in the Marquee on arrival. Please note cars MUST be unloaded as directed.

**Dismantling must take place after 6.00 pm and before 7.00 pm on Wednesday 23rd June 2010.** Trophies to be presented on Wednesday 24th June 2009 in the Flower Marquee at 4.00 pm. Payment of Prize Money will take place from 4.00 pm.

**RULES**

- 1 The position occupied by all exhibitors will be decided by the Committee and a card with the name of each exhibitor will be placed in each space.
- 2 The Judges' decision will be final.
- 3 All classes must be arranged by the Exhibitor in the marquee without assistance, with the exception of Class F3 and Class F8.
- 4 All classes to be judged in accordance with NAFAS Competitions Manual Second Edition 2009.
- 5 All entries should be on the Official Entry Form which should be returned not later than 7th June 2010 addressed to **MRS. PAT BALLARD, WESTLEA, 22 LONG MEADOW, GAYTON, WIRRAL CH60 8QQ.**
- 6 Trophies are awarded for one year and must be returned to the Cheshire Agricultural Society, Clayhouse Farm, Flittogate Lane, Tabley, Knutsford, Cheshire WA16 0HJ by 1st April 2011.
- 7 Whilst the Society will take all reasonable steps to prevent injury to persons or damage to property, neither the Society nor its Officers or Servants accept responsibility for such injuries or damage howsoever caused and whether or not involving negligence on the part of any such Officers or Servants.

The Show, its Officers or Servants shall not be responsible for any accident, damage or loss however caused, that may occur to any Exhibitor or his Servant, or to any article, animal or property brought into the Show ground, or while entering or leaving the Showground. Each Exhibitor shall be solely responsible for any loss, injury or damage that may be done to or occasioned by, or arising from, any machinery, or other article or any animal or property exhibited by him. It is a condition of entry that each Exhibitor shall indemnify and hold harmless the Show from and against all actions, suits, expenses and claims on account of such damage or injury.

An EXHIBIT is composed of natural plant material, with or without accessories, contained within a space as specified in a Show Schedule

NAFAS Rules state that disqualifications will take place for the following reasons:-

- 1 Failure to comply with any specific requirements of a class as stated in a Show Schedule i.e. the measurements or the components
- 2 Inclusion of any fresh plant material that does not have its roots or the cut ends of its stems in water or water-retaining material. (For exceptions see the NAFAS Competitions Manual Second Edition 2009)
- 3 Inclusion of artificial plant material, (unless specifically allowed by a Show Schedule).

For further details and definitions please refer to the NAFAS Competitions Manual Second Edition 2009 in accordance with which all classes will be judged.
